

Hairdressing Courses

N.B. All part-time hairdressing courses are strictly reserved for those working and training full-time in professional hair salons. All part-time hairdressing students are interviewed prior to joining courses.

Junior Trade (HJTM) Monday 1.00 to 6.00pm €500

Students who have completed their First Year Apprenticeship may enrol for the Department of Education & Skills Junior Trade Examination class. Examination fee extra payable in January 2019. This course runs from September to April. Subjects covered are:

- Practice and Theory of Hairdressing
- Hairdressing Science

Senior Trade (HST) Tuesday 6.45-9.45 pm €500

Senior Trade (HET) Wednesday 6.45-9.45 pm €500

Students who have completed their Second Year Apprenticeship may enrol for the Department of Education & Skills Junior Trade Examination class. Examination fee extra, payable in January 2019. This course runs from September to April. Subjects covered are:

- Advanced Practice and Theory of Hairdressing

QQI Level 5 Barbering Techniques 5N3348 (BAR) 15 weeks Fee €400

Tuesday 3.00-6.00pm starts 6/11/2018



This programme module aims to equip the learner with the knowledge, skill and competence to use barbering techniques within the hairdressing and barbering industry, operating independently while Under general supervision. Students will cover all aspects of health and safety and client preparation. Students will learn different cutting techniques for men's hair to include scissors over comb, clippers over comb, tapering, texturising, outlining and detailing. Cutting and caring for facial hair will also be covered.

Models will be required. Students should be working full-time in a barbershop. Students will have practical and theory examinations at the end of their course.

Master Hairdresser Diploma (IHF) Monday 6.45 to 9.45 pm €280 per module

Awarded by Irish Hairdressers Federation (IHF)

Students must have at least 6 years' hairdressing experience (which may include training) to join this course. The course is of two years' duration, consisting of four modules. Two modules are taught each year and in the current session the modules are:

Practical Hairdressing (September 2018)

Business Management (January 2019)

Hairdressing Science (September 2019)

Supervisory Management (January 2020)

Examination fee extra. The diploma will only be awarded to candidates who have successfully completed all four module examinations. Candidates must be either personally registered members or employed by salons who are registered members of the IHF at the time of conferring.
