

Leaving Certificate Courses for September 2018

1. Note: All courses are in preparation for Leaving Certificate examinations of June 2018
2. Fee per subject is €230; course duration is 25 weeks.
3. Booklists to be supplied by teacher unless otherwise stated.

5. It will be possible for students to sit the Leaving Certificate examination in Crumlin College in June 2018 as External Candidates. Students enter and pay for their exam on www.exams.ie in January 2018. There is an examination fee which is approximately €100 for one subject.
6. Extensive private study and homework is essential for all Leaving Certificate subjects.

Mathematics Ordinary Level (MO1) Monday and Thursday 6.30 – 8.00pm fee €230

Mathematics Ordinary Level (MO2) Monday and Thursday 8.00 -9.30pm €230

Requirements for MO1 and MO2:

1. Scientific Calculator
2. Project Maths Texts & Tests 3 (Latest edition)
3. Leaving Certificate Ordinary Level Maths Exam Papers
4. Formulae and Tables Book (State Exams Commission)

Mathematics Higher Level (MH1) Saturday 10.15-1.15 pm €230

Higher Level Mathematics requires a great deal of personal commitment and time in order to be successful in the Leaving Certificate examination. This course is ideally suited to those who have some familiarity with the Higher Level Maths course content already, such as those repeating Maths or those who wish to improve their knowledge of Maths for College Science or Engineering courses.

Applied Mathematics Ordinary and Higher Level (APM) Tuesday and Thursday 5.00-6.30pm fee €230

This course is targeted at Leaving Certificate students who are unable to study this subject in their own schools. Because the course content is progressive, it is possible to offer Ordinary and Higher in the same class. Applied Mathematics is a very suitable subject for those going on to study Engineering or any College course with a high mathematical content.

English Higher Level (ENGH) Wednesday 6.30 -9.30pm Fee €230

A good standard of written English and an appreciation of English literature are essential for this course. Students will be expected to read the prescribed novel outside of class.

Geography Ordinary and Higher Level Tuesday 7-9 pm Fee €230

A Geography Field trip will take place. Dates TBC. There will be a fee payable for the Field Trip. Project work to be handed up in April 2018 as well as written examination in June 2018

Irish Foundation Level (IRF) Monday 7-9pm Fee €230

This course is suitable for a dedicated beginner and may be of interest to new Irish residents who wish to help their children with their Irish schoolwork. We are replacing our short Irish language courses with the Leaving Certificate Irish Foundation level. This highly structured course will give students basic competency in speaking, listening, reading and writing Irish. It is not compulsory to sit the Leaving certificate examination though the class is dedicated to this aim. Oral examinations will take place in March/April 2018 as well as written examinations in June 2018.

Irish Ordinary Level (IR01) Wednesday 7-9 pm Fee €230

Leaving Certificate Irish Ordinary Level is a requirement for joining an Garda Síochána. This course is suitable for people who have already completed Foundation Level Leaving Certificate Irish or who are repeating Ordinary Level Irish. Oral examinations will take place in March/April 2018 as well as written examinations in June 2018.

Irish Higher Level (IRH1) Tuesday 6.00 -8.30 pm Fee €230

A good standard of written and spoken Irish is a requirement for this class. Many students attending this course wish to progress to a Teacher Training course for Primary school teaching and need a Higher Level LC Irish Grade C or higher as an entry requirement. With dedication, this aim can be achieved. Oral examinations will take place in March/April 2018 as well as written examinations in June 2018.

History Ordinary and Higher Level (HIS01) Wednesday 7-9.30 pm

Project work to be handed up in April 2018 as well as written examination in June 2018.

Business Studies Ordinary and Higher Level (BS1) Thursday 6.30 -9.00 pm Fee €230**Spanish Ordinary and Higher Level (SPOH) Monday 7 -9pm Fee €230**

Approximately two years' experience of learning Spanish necessary for this course. Oral examinations will take place in March/April 2018 as well as written examinations in June 2018.

French Ordinary and Higher Level (FREN) Saturday Fee €230

Approximately two years' experience of learning French necessary for this course. Oral examinations will take place in March/April 2018 as well as written examinations in June 2018.
